What is Mittagundi camp?

We have teamed up with Mittagundi Outdoor Education Centre to offer adolescent siblings, aged between 14 and 17 years old, a unique five-day camp in Victoria's High Country Alpine Region.

This is a great opportunity to get off the grid, form lifelong memories, peer connections and push yourself outside your comfort zone. There is no electricity or mobile phone reception!

During the week young people can take part in nature-based activities like river rafting and will work together on Mittagundi farm, taking on
